

International CMR Colloquium



Practical information

The venue The Swedish Museum of Natural History is situated at the campus of Stockholm University. It was designed by the architect Axel Anderberg and opened in 1916. The best way to get to the museum from the city centre is to take the subway (red line towards Mörby) to Universitetet and then walk to the museum (see enclosed map). You may also take bus 50 from Odenplan to Naturhistoriska Riksmuseet. The registration will take place in the main entrance. The colloquium will be arranged in a room called Lilla hörsalen.

Airport transfer From Arlanda airport you may take the airport train Arlanda Express to Stockholm Central. The journey will take about 20 minutes. There is also a commuter train to Odenplan and from there it is possible to take bus 50 to Naturhistoriska Riksmuseet. In addition, there is also an airport coach to the city centre bus terminal (around 40 minutes). From Bromma airport there is an airport coach to the city centre. If you travel by taxi from the airport it is recommended to use Taxi Stockholm, Sverige Taxi or Taxi Kurir. These are companies with a high reputation. Smaller independent taxi companies are not recommended since travelling with them can sometimes be expensive. Ask for a fixed price to your destination.

Accommodation The closest hotel to Naturhistoriska Riksmuseet is Elite Arcadia Hotel (subway station Tekniska högskolan). From the hotel there is walking distance to Aula Magna (around 40 minutes). It is also possible to make use of the subway (one station). Around the central station there are many hotels although more expensive than Elite Arcadia. The journey from the Stockholm Central (T-Centralen) to Universitetet will take about 15 minutes.
